Diamond Disinfectant 1000 makes a Corona kill claim at a dilution of 4 ounces per 5 gallons of water. Safe on plastic.

DILUTION RATES

Corona Kill: Add 4 oz to 5 gallons of water

Sanitization of glassware, pots, etc: Add 1 oz per 4 gallons of water.

No potable rinse required.

General Disinfection: Add 3 ounces per 5 gallons of water. **Hospital Disinfection**: Add 3.5 ounces per 5 gallons of water.

E-SPRAY E1572: Add .4 ounces per 55 oz of water.

Statement Of Practical Treatment

Note To Physician
